FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- 1. Is there a cost to exhibit? Nil.
- 2. Can I sell my art? We will not be selling art at the Exhibition however we will have signage that encourages our visitors to contact the Artist directly for any sales.
- 3. Is the event insured? Bayside Council have insured the event.
- 4. How many visitors are you expecting across the weekend? We anticipate more than 1000 visitors across the weekend.
- 5. Is there a cost to enter the Botany Town Hall to see the Exhibition? Entry is via donation to the Bayside Women's Shelter, recommended as \$5. We will provide tap and go facilities and accept cash.
- 6. Are there other activities? Yes, Friday night we will hear from Louise Whelan, the feature artist, speaking about the inspiration for her work from 5pm, tickets \$25.00. On Saturday we are planning art classes by a local group and on Sunday a Town Hall Meeting where the community is invited to hear form a panel of experts discussing how to respond and support someone who is escaping domestic and family violence.

BAYSIDE WOMEN'S SHELTER

Bayside Women's Shelter is a crisis accommodation refuge for women and children escaping family and domestic violence in south east Sydney. We are a shelter in the Women's Community Shelters network, one of nine Shelters throughout NSW.

We work with our families to empower them with dignity and support them to guide them in rebuilding a safe and independent future. That may be to assist in their first steps to employment or education and training. We assess, with our families, their needs, it may be financial, legal, it may be medical and from this assessment, in the safety of our caseworkers, we help unpick the challenges and lay a smooth path, keeping children at school and learning, working to help intergenerational trauma to be resolved and not

continue to work against them in the future.

The Bayside Women's Shelter has 6 bedrooms where families can regain their confidence and make their plans. Following their time in Shelter, we work alongside them to move into transitional homes where they can rejoin their communities and make those future plans for their children and themselves. Bayside Women's Shelter is a community based charity with a voluntary Board of directors who ensure that strong corporate governance sits alongside best practice in Shelter for our families.

We engage with our communities to raise funds to continue to provide the important work to our families and to educate our community about domestic and family violence, working to end the scourge.

We have a long way to go, but we are dedicated, we are a lean operation, intentionally, work for the best outcomes possible.
